WHEREAS the Authors have decided to constitute to a TRUST with an initial nucleus corpus fund of Rs. 3006/- (Rupees three thousand six only) and execute a Deed of Trust in this behalf.

NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED AND DECLARED AS FOLLOWS.

I. THE AUTHORS of the Trust doth hereby constitute a Public Charitable trust with objects detailed hereunder for which they dedicate by way of an initial corpus fund a sum of Three thousand and six only (Rs. 3006/-).

II. THE name of the Trust shall be "SRI S.N.S. CHARITABLE TRUST".

III. THE office of the Trust for the time being shall be at 14, V.C.S. Nagar, G.N. Mills post, Coimbatore - 641 029 OR SUCH other place as the TRUSTEES may decide from time to time and may shift the registered office as and when they decide to do so.

IV. THE FIRST TRUSTEES of this TRUST shall be :

1. V.S.Veluswamy
2. S.N.Subbramanian
3. S.Rajalakshmi

V. THE OBJECTS OF THE TRUST ARE :

1. TO establish, maintain, run, improve, develop Education Institutions, Schools, Colleges, Polytechnics, Medical and Engineering Colleges and private Universities including Hostels, Research Associates and Institutions without any motive for profit and also take care and run institutions as per the objects of the Trust.

2. TO seek and get affiliation of the various and other institutions run by the Trust and Private Universities to be formed in due course to various Universities of different disciplines.

3. TO establish, promote, set up, maintain, assist, finance, support, aid to or help in the setting up, maintaining, running Orphanages, widow Homes, Lunatic Asylums, Poor Houses and other establishments for relief, help to the poor, old and destitutes.

4. TO give, provide, render help and assistance in cash or kind to poor, destitutes people, widows, etc.,

5. TO give, provide, render help, and assistance to implement any scheme for providing livelihood and upliftment of the poor.

6. TO give, provide, render food, medicine and other help, assistance in any shape or form to the poor deserving and needy persons.

7. TO give, provide and render monetary and other help and assistance for the relief of persons and animals affected by natural & other calamities such as flood, fire, famine, cyclone, earthquake, Storm, accident, pestilence, drought, epidemic, unbearable cost of living and the like to give donations, subscriptions or contributions to institutions, establishments, e\centers or persons doing relief work on such occasions.

8. TO start, maintain and assist any relief measures in those parts which will be subjected to natural calamities such as flood, fire, drought, famine, cyclone, earth-quake, epidemic, Strom, accident, pestilence, etc.

9. TO open, establish, promote, set-up, run, maintain assist, finance, support, aid or help in the setting up, maintaining and running Hospitals, Boarding Houses, Libraries, Reading Rooms and other Training and Vocational Institutions.

10. TO foster and encourage education and training in handicrafts, fine arts among women folk in general and establish institutions imparting such as spiritual and secular education and to establish, maintain, support and help- by monetary gifts or otherwise, centers and institutions for women and children.

11. TO open, establish, promote, set-up, run maintain, assist, finance, support, aid or help in the setting maintaining and running hospitals, Charitable Dispensaries, Maternity Homes, Child Welfare Centers, Convalescent Homes, Sanitariums, hostels and other similar institutions or centers for rendering or providing medical relief and/or aid to the suffering humanities or for research and education for medical science including surgery.

12. TO open, establish, promote, set-up, run, maintain, assist, finance, support, aid or help in the setting up, maintaining and running marriage halls, aid poor in the conduct of marriage, donate cash or in kind and assist in marriage of the poor widows.

13. TO promote, subscribe, assist or amalgamate with or carry on the activities of any other Trust, Society, Association, Organisation whether incorporated or not having similar objects.

14. TO acquire immovable properties by purchase, lease, hire, exchange or otherwise and to put down, erect, alter and maintain building for carrying out the activities of the Trust.

15. TO undertake such other activities as may be necessary for the promotion of the objects of the Trust.

16. TO take over any existing Educational Institution in India with similar objects and to run, maintain, develop and improve the same.

17. TO provide mid-day meal facilities to poor students of any Educational Institutions and to distribute clothing and the like free of cost or at concessional rates.

18. TO construct, maintain and run community centers, choultries and public halls for conducting performance of the Art and celebration of Marriages and other functions.

19. TO acquire agricultural lands, develop them into farm and carry on agricultural, horticultural, gardening, diary farming and allied activities without profit motive in order to augment the resources of the Trust and to apply the same for the objects of the Trust.

20. TO sponsor, initiate and aid or undertake any research or Investigation in the fields of science, Sociology and Industry and to grant donations and/or financial assistance to Institutions engaged in such activities.

21. TO manage, improve, develop, sell, transfer, lease out, exchange, mortgage or charge or otherwise dispose of or deal with the property of any kind, moveable and immovable, belonging to the Trust;

22. TO carry on, manage, run and otherwise deal in agro-based industry, forest-based industry, small scale and cottage and khadi industries, printing and/or publishing of books and magazines, production of bio-gas and non-conventional energies and solar energies, and other permissible trade and industries including export and import independently and/or in collaboration or co-operation with other persons, societies or institutions as the Governing Body of the Trust may from time to time determine for promotion of and in connection with any of the objects of the Trust:

23. TO make, accept, endorse, discount, execute, and issue Promissory Notes, Bills of Exchange, and other negotiable or transferable instruments;

FOR the removal of doubts, it is hereby declared that all the objects of the Trust will be carried out without any motive for profit.

THE income and funds of the trust will be solely utilised towards the objects of the trust and no portion of it will be utilised for payment to trustees by way of profit, interest, dividends etc., and the benefits of the trust will be open to all irrespective of caste, religion, sex etc.

THE trust will not carry any activity with the intention of earning profit and no activities of the trust will be carried out outside India.

VI TRUST BOARD :

THE authors hereby affirm that the First Trustees of the Trust shall be the persons herein before referred to as the trustees including the Author.

1. All the Trustees who are for the time being and from time to time in office shall be referred to collectively as BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

2. All the aforesaid First Board of Trustees shall hold office as such for the duration of their respective lives or until they resign and each of them shall have the right to nominate their successors by will or otherwise.

3. THE other Trustees shall be chosen by the TRUST BOARD if so desired for such period as they deem fit with the consent of atleast two - third of Trustees including Managing Trustee. Fraction of two - third will be ignored. Any person/s appointed as member of the Board of Trustees shall hold office only for such period for which he is appointed or till he voluntarily resigns whichever is earlier.

4. A single member may constitute Board when the number of members are reduced to one and such member shall have the right to co opt one or more members to the Board of Trustees and fill up any vacancy in the Board; however, such member shall constitute the Board only for a period of six months from the date of such reduction of strength of the Board to one and such member shall appoint members to increase the strength of the Board.

5. A member of the board of Trustees other than a life member may be removed, provided atleast a majority of 2/3 of the members of the Board of Trustees give their consent to the removal of such member. Fraction of 2/3 will be ignored.

6. THE Trustee shall elect one among themselves as "Managing Trustee" whose office shall be co-extensive with his Trusteeship. The Managing Trustee shall administer and manage the Trust and exercise all such power of the Board as may be delegated. The Managing Trustee shall hold office for a term of three years or until he resigns which ever is earlier. They are eligible for reappointment as Managing Trustee for further periods.

7. In the event of any vacancy being caused for whatever reason in the office of the Managing Trustee, the Trustee shall first be chosen in the vacancy caused by the exit of Managing Trustee and thereafter the Managing Trustee will be appointed in accordance with clauses 6 supra. The Trustee so appointed shall also participate in the election of Managing Trustee.

8. ON Any vacancy arising in this office of Trustee for any reason or cause whatsoever, his successor shall be chosen by the Trust Board with the consent of atleast two-third of Trustees. Fraction of two-third will be ignored.

9. The administration, direction and management of several Institutions and establishments in terms of the Trust hereby created shall subject to the supervision, control and direction of the Board be with the Board of Trustee. In the event of any difference of opinion, the Managing Trustee shall be bound by the decision of the majority of the Board.

10. The Trustees will be entitled to honorarium or reasonable remunerations for their services or works actually rendered to the Trust in carrying out the objects and purposes of the Trust and to reimburse themselves for all expenses actually incurred or spent by them in connection with the Trust or affairs of the Trust or their duties relating thereto.

11. A person shall cease to be a Trustee if he or she :

(i) leaves without absence;

(ii) does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Trust or fails to attend meetings for one calender year, whichever is longer;

(iii) is requested to resign by 3/4th of the Trustees or as near to this number as possible of the remaining Trustees.

VII. MANAGING COMMITTEE :

1. With a view to carry out the objects of the Trust herein above mentioned and to augment its funds and to administer them, the Board of Trustees shall have the power to appoint committees, Sub committees from among the members of the Board or along with others and assign duties and seek suggestions for the purpose of the working of the Trust.

2. The Managing committee shall not exceed Ten members including the office Bearers, namely MANAGING TRUSTEE, SECRETARY CUM TREASURER.

3. The first Managing Committee shall consist of First Trustees and shall be in office for a period of Three years. Subsequently the General Body shall elect the members. The Managing Trustee shall nominate the rest of his executives from among the members. After the expiry of three years all the members in the executive committee are eligible for Re-election.

4. IT shall meet atleast once in three months or as often as necessary.

5. The Board of Trustees shall have the power either to remove any member of the Committee or to dissolve the Committee/Committees so appointed from time to time. in the best interests of the Trust.

6. The Managing Committee should consider all the matters which come under the purview of the Managing Committee.

7. The Board of Trustees shall delegate the following powers to the Managing Committee to carry out the affairs of the Trust in fulfillment of the objects of the Trust. Notwithstanding anything contained herein, the Board of Trustees shall be at liberty to revoke the powers so delegated to the Committee from time to time in the best interests of the Trust.

VIII. POWERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE :

I. MANAGING TRUSTEE.

1. TO conduct all correspondence on behalf of the Managing Committee.

2. The Managing Trustee shall act as the chairman of the General body.

3. The day to day affairs of the Trust shall be vested with the Managing Trustee.

4. The Managing Trustee shall at any time when he deems proper, communicate to the Trust or Managing Committee on such matters and shall make such suggestions as may in his opinion tend to promote prosperity and welfare of the Trust.

5. To administer and attend all the legal proceedings of the Trust.

6. The Managing Trustee of the Board shall have custody and control of all the documents, accounts of the receipts and payments and the assets and liabilities of the Trust and other papers, matters and things relating to the Trust and its properties.

7. Any Trustee who resigns his membership in the trust shall automatically cease to be member of the Trust. The Board of Trustees shall accept the resignation of Trustee if they so desire during their tenure of office and the Board shall have power to remove any Trustee if he is detrimental to the object of the Trust and shall be disqualified to be Trustee under the Trust Act. Such member shall have a right to appeal to the General Body whose decision is FINAL.

8. In the event of the votes being equally divided, the Managing Trustee shall have a casting vote in addition to his vote as member of the board/committee.

9. No act or resolution of the Board shall be invalid merely by reason of there being one or more vacancies in the Board.

10. The members of the Committee/Board of Trustees shall be indemnified against any expenses and losses incurred or suffered or any payments made by them in the administration of the trust and such expenses, losses and payments shall be borne by the Trust and none of the members of the Committee/Board of Trustees shall in any way be personally liable or responsible for the same.

11. The Board shall be entitled to make and prescribe from time to time rules and by-laws, regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and all other matters incidental to carry out objects of the Trust and also modify or amend such by-laws and rules and regulations within the frame work of the TRUST.

II. SECRETARY CUM TREASURER :

1. SECRETARY is jointly or solely the Principal Executive Officer of the Trust and he shall be responsible to the Managing Committee for the Performance of the Following specified duties in general.

- Shall carry on all correspondence on behalf of the Trust.
- Shall convene all meetings of the Trust, General Body and the Executive Committee and maintain a record of the Minutes of all such Meetings.
- Shall attend to all matters of general Administration in accordance with the directions of the Executive Committee and keep true and proper accounts of Transactions of the Trust.
- Shall be the custodians of all records and other properties of the Trust and shall be responsible to the Managing Trustee.
- Shall be ex-office member and convener of all committees.
- Shall give to all members notice before 21 days regarding convening the General Body Meeting.
- Shall administer and attend to all other matters and affairs of the Trust.
- Shall open a Bank Account in any of the Scheduled/Nationalized Bank(s) in the name of the Trust in accordance with the instructions of the Managing Trustee.
- Shall make disbursements on the requisition of the Secretaries and shall maintain Vouchers countersigned by him.
- Shall keep proper accounts and records for all transactions and place them before the Committee.

2. All cheques drawn on the Bank Account of the Trust shall be signed by Treasurer and Countersigned by the Managing Trustee or in his absence by the Assistant Managing Trustee or in accordance with the instructions of the Board of Trustees.

IX. GENERAL BODY MEETING :

1. EVERY year an Annual General Body Meeting shall be convened in the month of JUNE. Notice should be sent to all members atleast 21 days before the meeting. The Financial Year of the Trust shall be from April to March, every year.

2. Resolutions may be passed without holding a meeting of the Trustees by circulating in writing the proposed resolutions which must be endorsed by two-thirds of the Trustees. If resolutions are endorsed in this manner, they shall be as valid and effectual as resolutions passed at a meeting of the Trustees.

X. ADVISORY BOARD :

1. THE Board of Trustees may constitute an advisory Board in regard to the conduct and affairs of Trust and its activities. The Board shall determine the persons who shall constitute the Advisory Board, the terms and conditions of their appointment and their venture. However, the Advisory Board shall consist of persons who are experts in various fields which are relevant to the objects, scheme and activities of the Trust and whose presence in the Advisory Board shall be conducive to the purpose and affairs of the Trust.

XI. POWERS OF THE TRUSTEES :

1. ALL the properties, funds and assets of the Trust shall vest with the Trustees and shall be in complete management of the affairs of the trust.

2. THE Board of Trustee shall have the power of administration, employment, removal of employees, etc.

3. THE Board of Trustees may meet for the despatch of business, adjourn and otherwise regulate their meeting as they think fit. The Managing Trustee shall summon meetings of the Board of Trustees. The Managing Trustee shall be entitled to exercise one additional casting vote in the event of equality of vote.

4. THE Trustees shall have power to augment the funds of the Trust from any source including from abroad by accepting donations, voluntary contribution of any kind, if they think such acceptance is in the interests of Trust and acceptable to the provisions of law.

5. WITHOUT prejudice to the above such general powers, the Trustees shall have powers;

a) TO buy, sell, negotiate and enter into contracts, rescind, and vary such contracts, make advances upon and pay for the purchase of all the materials, stores, machinery and other goods required;

b) TO purchase, lease, license, let-out, provide, erect, maintain and keep-up lands, buildings, equipments and materials and to sell, mortgage or dispose of all or any of the same as the Trustees may think fit;

c) TO execute; become party, to sign, acknowledge, perfect and register all deeds, arrangements and to give effectual discharge on behalf of Trust;

d) TO borrow from time to time such sums of monies for such period on such terms with or without security as the Trustees may think fit;

e) TO Draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, negotiate, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, hundies, cheques, Government and other securities and other negotiable instruments;

f) TO initiate, conduct, defend, compound, withdraw, compromise, adjust, refer to arbitration or abandon and legal or other proceedings, claims, or disputes by or against the Trust of Trustees or against its officers or employees concerning, the affairs of the Trust and to sign and verify vakalaths, plaints, statements, execution petition, affidavits and other proceedings;

g) TO open and close accounts with Banks to operate upon such accounts, to pay and draw money from such accounts and otherwise deal with the same and powers in this behalf shall be exercised by the Board of Trustee or by any other Trustee empowered by a resolution of the Board of Trustees in a meeting or as directed by them;

h) TO insure and keep insured, if deemed expedient, all or any of the buildings and other assets of the Trust;

i) GENERALLY to carry out transactions as they consider expedient in the interest of the Trust and to make all such arrangements and do such acts and things on behalf of the Trust as may be usual, necessary, desirable or expedient for the managements of the affairs of the Trust or in carrying out its objects;

j) TO invest the funds of the Trust only in any investments authorised under the provisions of Income Tax Act and other Direct Tax Acts which will enable the Trust to avail the exemption available thereunder.

k) TO establish agencies or branches in India or abroad and to undertake the management of the Trust or any branch of the Trust or other organisations having aims and objects all or in part similar to those of this Trust;

l) TO make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the aims and objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the effect to the aims and objects of the Trust;

m) TO do any other thing which is incidental and conducive to the attainment of the above aims and objects or any one of them.

6. WHENEVER for the administration of the Trust hereby created or for the establishment, development and conduct of the several institutions maintained hereunder, grants-in-aid from Government are applied for and obtained and it becomes necessary for the due performance of the conditions of such grants to secure the same by mortgage or charge on the properties of the Trust, the Board shall have power to create such mortgages or charges on all or any of the Trust properties to facilitate the obtaining of such grants for purchase of lands and for administration, conduct and maintenance of such institutions.

7 THE Managing Trustee shall, if and when, so authorised by Board b.y means of resolution passed at a meeting of the Board, have power and authority to execute such documents as are necessary: - favour of Government for and/on behalf of the Board in respect of mortgages or charges to be created on all or any of the properties of the Trust as the Board may from time to time decide.

8. The Trustees may at any time receive or accept with or without invitation any assignment, contribution or donation of all nature in cash or in kind from the Settler or any member of his family ~~or from the trustees or from any member~~ of the public or from any firm, company, institutions including charitable institution, family or other trust or association or other entities or body for all or any of the objects and purposes of the trust without any condition or on such conditions as they deem fit.

9. The Trustees may in the interest of the Trust and in conformity with its objects raise public fund by means of lotteries or by organising functions, fetes, charity shows etc. and/or publishing brochures and souvenirs and booking advertisements in such publications or may do such similar acts.

10. The Trustee or Trustees for the time being of the said Trust may reimburse themselves or himself and discharge out of the Trust property all expenses incurred in or about the execution of the Trust or powers under these presents and/or for the realisation, preservation or benefit of the Trust Fund or property.

11. The Trustees may appoint Auditor, Secretary, Accountant, employee, workers, staff, Agents and Contractors etc. of the Trust on such terms and remuneration and with such power to be expressed on such acts to be done by them on behalf of the Trustees as the Trustees may from time to time decide and to dispense with the services of such persons and appoint in his or their place or places as and when the Trustees may deem fit.

12. The Trustees shall be competent to execute, grant or delegate the powers of Attorney, Letter of Authorities, Vakalatnamas to any person or persons who might be required to assist the interest, assets and affairs of the Trust and for such purpose the signature of any one of the Trustees shall be binding and valid for and on behalf of this Trust.

13. That the trustees shall have power to make amendments to the provisions of the trust wherever so required not inconsistent with the object of the trust.

14. The Trustees by a resolution of majority will be at liberty to appoint a trustee or trustees and/or discharge any of the trustee or trustees without assigning any reason.

15. The Trustees may reimburse themselves and pay and discharge out of the trust funds all expenses incurred by them in or about the execution of the Trust or in exercise of powers conferred under these presents.

XII. ASSETS OF THE TRUST :

1. THE Trust assets shall comprise of all funds received as donations whether as corpus fund otherwise all income the investments, movable and immovable properties acquired by gift, purchase, lease or otherwise and all the properties shall be held either in the name of the Trust or in the names of the Trustees as the circumstances may require.

XIII. ACCOUNTS :

1. THE Accounts of the Trust shall be closed every year on 31st March and Income and expenditure Account and Balance Sheet on that date shall be prepared. The surplus fund if not applied within the year of account shall be accumulated for any specified object of the Trust and invested in any manner authorised under the Income Tax Act for the time being.

2. THE Account of the Trust shall be audited every year by a qualified Chartered Accountant.

XIV. GENERAL :

1. THIS Trust is hereby declared expressly that this TRUST shall be irrevocable and is a PUBLIC CHARITABLE TRUST.

2. THE Trust shall confirm to the provisions of the INDIAN TRUST ACT, 1882 in all matters not expressly provided for herein but in case any difficulty or doubt arises on any question in respect of the management or administration of the Trust or any matters falling hereunder, the Managing Trustee may on behalf of the Board apply to the court for opinion, advise, direction or order and the Trustees acting upon the direction, if any, of the Court shall be deemed so far as regards their responsibility to have discharged their duties in respect thereof.

3. THIS Trust may be extinguished at any time if the majority of the members of the Board of Trustees decide to so extinguish the Trust and all the life-time Trustees consent there of. Upon dissolution of the Trust the entire trust funds shall be realised and first be used for payment of liabilities of the Trust, and for meeting expenses of realisation. The balance left, if any, shall be donated to such institutions having similar objects as may be decided by the Majority of the Board of Trustees.

4. Any amendment to trust deed will be carried out only with the approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax.

XV. AMALGAMATION :

It shall be lawful for the Trust to take over or amalgamate with any other charitable trust, society, association or institution with similar aims and objects. It shall also be lawful for the Trust to establish, promote, manage, organise or maintain, or to assist in establishing, promoting, managing, organising or maintaining any branch of the Trust to promote or carry on the affiliation or amalgamation of any other charitable trust, society, association or institution with this trust.

XVI. JURISDICTION :

1. The Trust shall be authorised to function throughout India.
2. Should any legal disputes, claims or litigation within the jurisdiction of the law arise, they will only be considered valid if they are lodged within the precincts of the city of Coimbatore.



